MPD History and Current Staff were gone over in detail to the HOA Board

One of the best take aways was MPD introducing a national Program called Crime Free Housing to be initiated in Middletown. In summary there would be a lease addendum to all rental properties to keep all illegal activity off rental property. It would enable tennents to be evicted if they, or their family or guests are convicted of a crime while at the rental property. MPD History: The newly formed Middletown Police Department started in the fall of 2007 with 20 experienced, sworn officers from various Police Agencies. This included 2 senior staff (Chief & Lt.), 2 Patrol Supervisors (Sgts.), 1 Detective, 1 K-9 Officer and 14 Patrol Officers.

MPD Present: Today our strength is at 31 sworn officers (5 New Graduates). This includes 4 Senior Staff, 3 Detectives, 4 Patrol Supervisor and 17 Patrol Officers, 2 Assigned to Traffic Services (TSU), 1 Assigned to Community Services.

Special Units: SWAT, Crisis Negotiations (CNT), Honor Guard.

CALEA: The Middletown Police Department became certified in 2014 through CALEA which is a highly respected accreditation agency for law enforcement.

Initiatives: Community Advisory Board, Crime Free Housing - National Program
